ORDER

S.R.O. 26(1)/2010. - In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Imports and Exports (Control) Act, 1950 (XXXIX of 1950), the Federal Government is pleased to order that.

- (a) export of cotton yarn is allowed to the extent of fifty million kilogram per month with immediate effect and till the 30th June 2010;
- (b) the export is allowed subject to registration of export contract by Trade Development Authority of Pakistan (TDAP).
- (c) the monthly ceiling of fifty million kilogram shall not apply to export of following yarn, namely:
 - (i) lycra;
 - (ii) dyed;
 - (iii) heather grey or m elange;
 - (iv) slub; or
 - (v) bleached or singed:

Provided the exporting units are registered with the Ministry of Textile Industry and the consignment are certified, to be any of those specified in sub-clause (i) to (v), by accredited laboratories.
